

# LEARN TO PLAY POKER WAR

**Poker War is a fun, simple game that is easy to learn. The aim of the game is to beat the Dealer by having a higher value card than the Dealer's highest card.**


## HOW TO PLAY

At the start of each game the Dealer will ask you to "place your bets". To commence play, place a bet on the area of the table marked Bet.

You can also place a bet on Poker Pursuit which is a side wager that uses your card and the Dealer's two cards to make a poker hand. If these three cards make a Straight Flush, Three of a Kind, Straight or Flush you will win.

Once all players have placed their bets, the Dealer will announce "no more bets" and deal one card face-up to each player and two cards face-down to themselves.

After you receive your card you can choose to either Raise, Trade or Check.



## RAISE

If you think you can beat the Dealer, you can Raise. To Raise, you must place another bet which is equal to your first bet, on the area of the table marked Raise.

## TRADE

If you don't think you can beat the Dealer, you can swap or Trade your card for a new one. To Trade, place another bet equal to your first bet on the area of the table marked Trade, and the Dealer will deal you one more card. This new card or Trade card is the one that will be used against the Dealer's card to determine whether you win or lose.

*If you think your Trade card can beat the Dealer, you can also Raise.*

## CHECK

If you don't want to Raise or Trade, you can Check. To Check means you don't want to trade your card or add more to your original bet. Let the Dealer know you want to Check by tapping the table.

Once all players have decided to Check, Raise or Trade, the Dealer turns over his/her cards. The highest value card is the Dealer's final card.

You will win if your card or Trade card is higher than the Dealer's highest card. If the cards are the same, the result is a Tie.

Winning bets placed on Bet, Raise and Trade will be paid according to the Poker War pay table

Poker Pursuit bets are independent of your Poker War bet(s). A Straight Flush, Three of a Kind, Straight or Flush will be paid the relevant odds described in the Poker Pursuit pay table
