



HOW TO PLAY

Objective

The aim of the game is to wager on which die, Gold or Red, will show the highest result.

How to play

There are nine permissible wagers that a player may place: Gold, Red, Tie and specific numbers 1 – 6.

The dealer will pass the Gold dice cup to the PLAYER with the highest wager on Gold. The PLAYER will then shake the die in the dice cup and return the dice cup to the dealer. The dealer will then reveal the Gold die.

The dealer will then hand the Red dice cup to the PLAYER with the highest wager on Red. The PLAYER will shake the die in the dice cup and return the dice cup to the dealer. The dealer will then reveal the Red die. When both dice have been revealed, the die with the highest score will be announced the winner.



Tie

If both dice display the same result, it is a tie and Gold and Red will stand off (tie on 2, 3, 4, 5, 6). If the tie result is 1, Gold and Red will lose.

Specific numbers

The specific number betting options are 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6. 'Specific number' allows you to win on individual die results regardless of the winning colour.

Event	Odds
Gold	1 to 1
Red	1 to 1
Tie	4 to 1
Tie on 6	8 to 1
Specific number (1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6)	2 to 1 (One die) 4 to 1 (Two dice)
