

Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot

Terms & Conditions

1. Texas Hold'em Bad Beat Jackpot (**Jackpot**) runs from 1 August to 30 September 2026, unless retired early by Crown
2. The Jackpot applies to **Texas Hold'em** cash games only (**Poker Game**).
3. The Jackpot value will be determined by Crown Melbourne Limited (**Crown**). Once the Jackpot has been won, Crown may reset the Jackpot value amount or conclude the Jackpot in its absolute discretion. The Jackpot figure display in the Poker Room shall be the official Jackpot value and will be updated as required by Crown management.
4. **Eligibility.** For players to be eligible to win the Jackpot, a minimum of two (2) active players must be seated and dealt a hand into the Poker Game, players must have placed a blind and be dealt cards into the Poker Game (**Eligible Players**).
5. **Qualifying Hands.** For a hand to qualify for the Jackpot:
 - a. the hand must proceed to a full showdown;
 - b. all betting action must be completed; and
 - c. all remaining players must expose their cards to determine the winning and losing hands as follows:
 - i. The losing hand (**Bad Beat Hand**) must be:
 - Four of a Kind Tens or better; and
 - beaten by a higher-ranking poker hand.For example,
 - Four of a Kind Tens losing to Four of a Kind Jacks;
 - Four of a Kind losing to a Straight Flush; or
 - Four of a Kind losing to a Royal Flush.
 - ii. The winning hand (**Winning Hand**) may be:
 - a higher Four of a Kind;
 - a Straight Flush; or
 - a Royal Flush.
 - d. The Bad Beat Hand and Winning Hand must use both hole cards to make their final five-card hand. For example, for any Four of a Kind hand to qualify, the player must hold a Pair that forms part of Four of a Kind.

6. **Multiple Qualifying Hands.** If more than one (1) Bad Beat Hand qualifies during the showdown, all qualifying Bad Beat Hands will share in the Jackpot distribution in accordance with the payout structure outlined at clause 8) below.
7. **Simultaneous Jackpots.** In the event than one (1) or more tables qualify for the Jackpot at exactly the same time (as confirmed by Surveillance), the Jackpot will be split equally between the qualifying tables *before* the Jackpot distribution set out clause 8) below.
8. **Jackpot Distribution.**
- a. Single Bad Beat Hand. Where only one (1) Bad Bead Hand qualifies:
 - i. Bad Beat Hand receives 50% of the Jackpot;
 - ii. Winning Hand receives 30% of the Jackpot; and
 - iii. 20%of the Jackpot to be divided equally among remaining Eligible Players.
 - b. Two Bad Beat Hands. Where two (2) Bad Beat Hands qualify:
 - i. Highest Bad Beat Hand receives 40% of the Jackpot;
 - ii. Second highest Bad Beat Hand receives 30% of the Jackpot;
 - iii. Winning Hand receives 20% of the Jackpot; and
 - iv. 10% of the Jackpot to be divided equally among all remaining Eligible Players.
9. **Poker Rules.** All players must abide by 'Crown Melbourne Limited Table Games Rules Poker' as approved by the Victorian Gambling and Casino Control Commission (**VGCCC**) (**Poker Rules**). Any contravention of the Poker Rules may render the Jackpot void, and Crown Management reserves its discretion to investigate and decide on any suspected breach of the Poker Rules. All decisions made by Crown management regarding these Terms and Conditions and distribution of this Jackpot shall be final.
10. Valid photo identification may be required before any Jackpot payment is made. Failure to provide valid photo identification may result in delayed or denied payment.
